

Testing Process

The Developer starts writing code (program) based on the BRD (Or Design Document OR Uses Cases)



Business Requirement Document (BRD)

The Tester writes the Test Cases (TC) based on the BRD (Or Design Document OR Uses Cases)

If Design Document is available, then refers this to write code.

If Use Case is available, then refers this to write Code

Design Document (Some companies have this, some don't)

If Design Document is available, then refers this to write TCs

If Use Case is available, then refers this to write TCs

The Tester executes the Test Cases against code written by developers and finds bugs. The bugs are reported using tools like ClearQuest, Quality Center, Bugzilla and so on. (If no tools are available, then use Excel Sheet)
